1. The golfer who scored a 60 was either Walter Branbeck or the man who won in 1983.


2. The golfer who won in 1982 was either the one who scored a 59 or Sam Elliot.

3. Of the golfer who who's best hole was the 17th and Thomas Bracken, one won in 1982 and the other shot a 63.

4. The golfer who won in 1980 got a hole in one on the 11th.

5. Sam Elliot won his tournament sometime before the golfer who scored a 63.

6. The person who scored a 60 won his tournament 1 year after the person who came in first on hole 14.





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
