
Movie Buffs Associated - Harrison Ford Logic Puzzle ♀♀♀♀



Every week since its inauguration, the local Movie Buffs Associated have shown a series of movies chosen by a selection panel, determined annually by a ballot of members, in the Municipal Offices function room each evening from Monday to Friday, and starring a particular actor/actress. The selection panel for the current year is Sally Boyden, Mark Thomson, Jessica Farmer, Laurie Davison and Mary Peters.

Last week their choice was Harrison Ford, and the films chosen - one per member - were The Fugitive (1993), Witness (1985), Presumed Innocent (1990), Frantic (1988), and Regarding Henry (1991) but not respectively, and neither were they shown in that order, nor in the order in which they were released. Showing time differed each evening. From this information and the following clues, for each member, can you determine who chose which film, the day on which it was shown, and at what time?

- 1. There was a time difference of two hours plus 3 days between the showing of The Fugitive and Mark's 1988 choice.
- 2. Mr. Davison chose the movie shown mid-week.
- **3.** The 1985 release was shown the day before Mark's choice and two days after Regarding Henry.
- **4.** The showings which did not start on the hour were that at 7:30 pm and the one on Thursday.
- 5. The last showing was also the latest.
- 6. Mary had a showing on an even-numbered day, as did Miss Farmer at 8:15 pm.



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
