- Harris is at the fourth position.
- Miller's favorite ice cream is Chocolate.
- The youngest boy is next to the boy that is wearing the Green shirt.
- Young is at the third position.
- The 9-year-old boy is exactly to the left of Young.
- Kevin is next to the 9-year-old boy.
- At the second position is the boy wearing the Black shirt.
- Daniel likes Strawberry ice cream.
- At the fourth position is the boy who likes Vanilla ice cream.
- The 7-year-old boy is somewhere between the boy wearing the Blue shirt and the 8-year-old boy, in that order.
- Nicholas is at the third position.
