

- **3.** "Belly Laughs" has 100,000 fewer views than the video that's 54 seconds long.
- 4. Kayla's viral video received 700,000 views.
- 5. SooSoo18's viral video is "Young And Free".
- **6.** Of SooSoo18's video and "Going For A Ride", one is 1 minute, 9 seconds long and the other received 600,000 views.
- 7. The video that's 61 seconds long is either "Young And Free" or Kayla's viral video.
