**Smoke:** Chesterfield, Kools, Lucky Strike, Old Gold, Parliament

**Pet:** dog, fox, horse, snails, zebra

- The Spaniard owns the Dog.
- The man who smokes Chesterfields lives in the house next to the man with the Fox.
- Coffee is drunk in the Green house.
- Kools are smoked in the house next to the house where the Horse is kept.
- The Ukrainian drinks Tea.
- The Lucky Strike smoker drinks Orange juice.
- The Green house is immediately to the right of the Ivory house.
- The Japanese smokes Parliaments.
- The Old Gold smoker owns Snails.
- The Norwegian lives next to the Blue house.
- Kools are smoked in the Yellow house.
- Milk is drunk in the middle house.

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
